

GOVERNANCE

- The Trust has a board of eleven trustees and has included women for the last seven years.
- All Trustees volunteer their time and effort.
- Trustees are highly qualified in a range of professions, e.g. legal, building, medical, education.
- The Board meets monthly.

- The Trust is under the leadership of a General Manager.

The Napier District Masonic Trust was set up under the Charitable Trusts Act 1967 to assist in charitable, educational and scientific purposes, to supply the needs of the sick, aged and the infirm and to help the needy, as well as to assist organisations of similar mind. It was incorporated on December 1st 1961.
