Through the **My Covid Record website** you can now request two official records of your COVID-19 vaccination status.

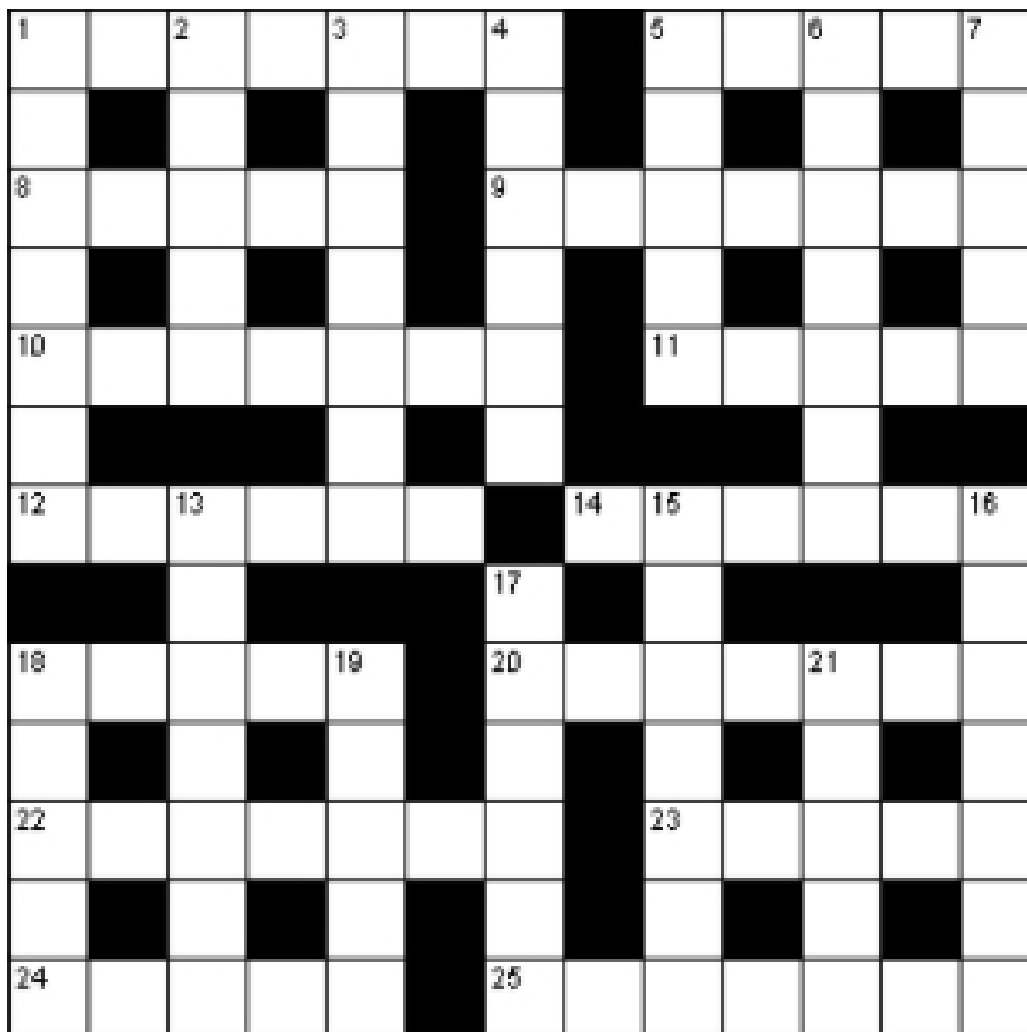
